3rd Floor

Intensive Care Unit

- Separate doors for entrance and exit
 - *There should be a lavatory for handwashing near the entrance door.*
- Visitor's Dressing Room
 - *Should have direct access to the corridor.*

- With at least 3 negative pressure rooms
- Room dimension should be at least *4 meters x 4 meters*

Respiratory Therapy Unit

- Pulmonary Function Testing (PFT) Room with good ventilation
- Arterial Blood Gas (ABG) room
- Pantry
- Ante Room
- Donning & Doffing area
- Wash area
- Toilet & bath
- Administrative office
- Storage room for equipments that can accommodate at least 40 mechanical ventilators
- Washing and drying area for equipments located near the storage room

Conference Rooms

- Divisible into 2 rooms separated by accordion
- Toilet for male, female & PWD located outside the conference rooms
- Sound system / Internet

4th Floor

General Ward

- 2 TB Rooms
One room for male (15 beds)

- *One room for female (15 beds)*
- 2 Rooms for Communicable Diseases
One room for male
One room for female
- 2 Rooms for Non-Communicable Diseases
One room for male
One room for female
- General Ward

- Reverse Isolation Rooms (PLHIV)
