## INVITATION FOR CONSIGNMENT Of Various Drugs and Medicines

1. The Region 11 Trauma and Medical Center (R2TMC), through the Medicines Consignment Committee invites suppliers/consignors to submit quotations for various drugs and medicines for consignment purposes.
2. The following shall be the primary basis for eligibility, among other requirements of the DOH:
  - a) Letter of Intent;
  - b) Price Quotation;
  - c) License to Operate (LTO) with at least 1-year validity;
  - d) Certification of Product Registration (CPR) with at least 1-year validity;  
Note: Kindly put label per requirement
3. In case the consignor has no transaction record at the R2TMC Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), the following shall be submitted along with the requirements listed in Number 2:
  - a) Securities and Exchange Commission Registration certificate for corporations/partnerships; or relevant Department of Trade and Industry Registration Certificate for sole proprietorships;
  - b) Business Permit from the local Government Unit which administratively covers the Consignee with which the Consignor intends to enter into a Consignment Agreement;
  - c) Sworn and duly notarized statement that the prospective Consignor has not been "blacklisted" to participate in biddings by any Government Agency, Local Government unit, or Government Owned or Controlled Corporation
4. Terms of Reference
  - a) List of drugs and Medicines brand/product must be the same as the sample presented and must conform with the specifications of the end-user;
  - b) Only drugs and medicines covered by the latest edition of the Philippine National Formulary (PNF) shall be covered by the DOH Drug Consignment System. The same must be covered by an appropriate CPR;

- c) Consignors cannot offer specific drug both in Consignment and Regular Procurement;
  - d) Where there are multiple consignors, and CONSIGNOR A is non-responsive with regards to delivery, R2TMC may then proceed with CONSIGNOR B (supplier with the next lowest calculated quotation). CONSIGNOR B, after satisfying all parameters of eligibility and responsiveness, must agree to sell their goods at the lowest price offered unless otherwise deliberated and approved by the head of R2TMC;
  - e) The Consignment Orders for the initial delivery must be good for three (3) months. Upon release of the Monthly Sales Report, the quantity issued shall be the basis for the quantity to be requested in the "End-User Request". The Pharmacy shall order replenishment to fill-in unforeseen contingencies, such as sudden depletion of that particular stock as a result of force majeure or calamities;
  - f) From the date of receipt of the Consignment Order, delivery shall take place within 10 working days;
  - g) The consigned goods shall be delivered directly to the Pharmacy in the presence of the Inspection and Acceptance Committee's Representative. There shall be no deliveries during weekends and holidays. The delivery of drugs and medicines shall be inspected by the Materials and Management Office and accepted by the Pharmacy Department;
  - h) A Delivery Receipt shall be issued by the Consignor for every delivery made to the Consignee;
  - i) Unconsumed Drugs and Medicines shall be returned to the Consignor at the end of the consignment period.
5. Properly **labeled and sealed in a red envelope** and must be personally delivered to the Consignment Secretariat on or before the hereunder deadline of submission. Late proposals shall not be accepted.


